Skaters may only enter the ice at the start of each session. Contract Ice can not be prorated.

Skaters will purchase contract ice for entirety of the Fall Session. Limit of 15 skaters on a freestyle.

(Subject to Change)

- *All skaters must complete a waiver and Covid-19 waiver, check in and pay before stepping onto the ice.
- *ALL coaches teaching lessons on Freestyle/Learn to Skate practices/Public Skate ice must provide certificate of insurance naming the Niles Park District as additionally insured.
- *Schedule/times subject to change. IceLand reserves the right to change or alter this schedule and it's information at anytime.
- *Coaching from anyone other than insured instructors that have submitted the required paperwork with IceLand is prohibited.
- *Blue jeans and street clothes are not allowed on any freestyle session. Freestyle session skaters must be dressed in skating type attire.
- *Thank you for helping to keep our freestyle sessions running in an effective, efficient, fair, and constructive manner. As such our skaters are better able to make the most of these sessions.

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2020 Fall Session Registration Information

Session Dates: October 5, 2020 through December 19, 2020

Skaters must pre-register for all sessions.

Weekday Freestyle Morning Rules ONLY

Updated: Niles Residents, Team IceLand Gold Club, Team IceLand Silver Club, Niles IceLand skaters with Niles IceLand Coaches may use a punch card for the weekday morning sessions and skate 30 minute sessions on the hour or half hour.

Weekday Afternoon and Saturday Morning Rules

Weekday afternoon sessions and Saturday morning session will continue to be sold as contract ice. You will have to purchase the entire session. No refunds, exchanges, or changes.

Registration Dates for Weekday Afternoon and Saturday Morning Freestyle Sessions:

September 28: Niles Residents/All Team IceLand 2020-2021 Gold Club Members.

September 30: Team IceLand 2020-2021 Silver Club members.

October 1: Niles IceLand Skaters. Any skater signed up for the 2020 Fall session of learn to skate classes.

October 3: Those skaters who have been skating on IceLand freestyle session with permission for the Summer 2020 session.

- Skaters must skate only during times contracted/signed in for and can not split times between freestyles.
- Skaters may register for as many sessions as they want.
- There will only be 15 skater spots per session during this time.
- · No makeup sessions.
- No refunds.
- Niles IceLand Coaches will be allowed on each session. Coaches who had previously had permission to teach at IceLand this past season from Summer 2019 through Spring 2020 may be permitted to teach lessons beginning July 6, 2020.*
- Parents, skaters and coaches will need to be flexible during this time.
- All policys are for the safety of our staff and skaters.
- All Weekday afternoon and Saturday morning Freestyle Sessions and Learn to Skate Practice Sessions will be in the form of
 pre-paid contract ice until further notice.
- Only Niles Residents and Niles IceLand Skaters may purchase Freestyle Sessions and Learn to Skate Practice Sessions.
- Registration for the freestyle contract ice will only be accepted at Aforbes@niles-parks.org, must be paid by credit card, with competed registration form, including our standard waiver with signature.
- Additional Covid-19 Waiver must be signed and returned at the time of registration. If one is on file you do not need provide another one.
- All weekday afternoon and Saturday morning sessions will be sold as listed on the current freestyle contract/schedule. The full session must be purchased.
- Punch cards may only be used for the weekday morning sessions by Niles residents, Team Iceland Gold club members,
 Team IceLand Silver Club members, Niles IceLand skaters with Niles IceLand coaches. Cards must remain current. Skaters must sign in upon entry. Failure to do so will result in loss of privileges.
- No monthly unlimited passes will be sold.
- There will be no refunds or make-ups for any reason. Credit will only be applied to households balances in the case that the park district cancels programming.



New Niles IceLand Procedures

- Facemasks will be required for all who enter the facility.
- Masks must be worn while in the building including while skating.
- It is recommended that skaters use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
- Skaters may not enter the facility until 5 minutes before their scheduled session and are required to exit
 the building immediately after their session. They must be marked present for each session they attend
 upon entry.
- Skaters must enter the facility with skates on, ready to get on the ice. Skaters will be allowed to bring their
 own water bottle in small bags to be brought to the ice with other items such as tissues, cell phones, etc.
 No skate bags will be allowed in the building. All items will be placed at least 6ft. apart.
- Skaters must abide by all signage regarding entering and exiting the building in the assigned areas.
- Parents will not be allowed in the building during Phase 4. Skaters age 10 an under may be dropped off
 at the assigned entrance so long as the parent is also wearing a mask. Parent can them pick their skater
 up outside of the building at the assigned exit.
- Markings will be displayed in six foot increments to allow for safe social distancing outside upon entry to the building. All participants are expected to abide by all signage.
- No walk-ins will be allowed.
- No locker rooms or benches will be available for use. Participants are encouraged not to touch any surfaces.
- Water fountains will NOT be available. Concession stand will NOT be open.
- We encourage skaters to use the bathroom before coming to the rink, however the bathrooms will be available and cleaned on a regular basis. One person will be allowed in at a time. Skaters must use hand sanitizer before entering the bathrooms and wash hands for at least 30 seconds prior to exiting the bathroom.
- Skaters may not use the cd player or be in the players boxes. Coaches may play music and must clean the area when they are done.
- Skaters may not share any items.
- Individuals will be asked to leave the facility if they: attempt to enter with more than their water bottle and small ice bag, display a temperature of 100.4 Degrees Fahrenheit, exhibit symptoms of Covid-19, do not practice social distancing, remove their face covering or loiter in the facility in non-designated areas.
- All coaches are in a position of authority and are responsible for the safekeeping of their athletes.
 Coaches need to exercise caution and common sense to avoid over training, fatiguing and harming their skaters that are required to wear CDC recommended face coverings.
- Coaches should teach from their assigned areas or be social distanced.
- Cleaning and disinfecting will be completed following each session also will a deep cleaning be done daily.
