Cook County Vaccine Requirement

Starting January 3, 2022, a Cook County order requires proof of vaccination for all guests at our facilities age 19 and over. Vaccination card or a clear photo are accepted with a valid photo ID.

Vaccination proof is NOT required for the following programs:

- Athletic programs, youth programs and activities for individuals 18 and under.
- Spectators of indoor sports where no food or beverage is being served.
- Any individual participating in special recreation programs.

Vaccination proof will still be required for individuals over 18 participating in any fitness or adult program. Masks are still required in our facilities.

We continue to ask for your patience, especially for our front-line staff, as we all adapt to this new requirement.

An individual is considered fully-vaccinated:

- Two weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series with an approved COVID-19 vaccine, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or
- Two weeks after a single-dose series with an approved COVID-19 vaccine, such as the Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
