Love to Skate? Try Our Specialty classes! Something for everyone!

Parent/Tot: Children ages 3-5 and a parent learn the basics of skating through games, songs, and having fun.

Teen/Adult: Skating fundamentals are presented sequentially at each skater's pace for a fun filled on ice experience!

Skate Into Synchro: PA2 - FS1 skaters learn to skate as a team. Lines, circles, blocks, pass throughs and more!

Alpha—Delta Power: PreAlpha 2 through Delta. Begin the development of strength, stamina, and edge quality.

Power & Style: FS1 and up. Improve edge quality and power while developing artistry and presentation with music.

Bag O' Tricks: FS1 & up. Learn fun interesting maneuvers, great for shows that aren't in Learn-to-Skate levels.

Dance/Ballet & Jazz ages 6—10 -OR- Dance 2 Ballet & Jazz ages 11 and up or instructor approval: Learn balance, technique, & artistry of dance for polished on ice performances.

Couples Class: FS1 & up. Sign up with a partner, learn couples maneuvers that are part of the ISI Couples test levels, choreograph a couples program to music. ISI testing is optional.

Floor Barre: This cross training workout improves strength and flexibility with an emphasis on skeletal and muscular alignment to help improve those beautiful spins, spirals, and more.

Music Interpretation: Gamma & up. Learn to develop skating programs to different genres of music, program patterns, ISI uncaptured moves, facial expressions, ISI interpretive event rules, and more.
