## Dates & Opportunities to Remember...

- We do not conduct testing during any Mini sessions. Be sure to enroll your child for summer in the same level that they are skating in the Mini session or the level indicated on their Spring evaluation form.
- Registration for the 9 week summer Learn-to-Skate session continues through June 9th. Sorry, there is a \$5 late fee after June 1st.
- The 9 week summer Learn-to-Skate session runs June 10th through August 17th.
- *FS 1 skaters and above! We are very pleased to offer our new Dance Class on Mondays 5:30—6:45pm during the summer. Learn ballet, jazz, and hip hop in a structured, challenging, and fun class. Dance is a must for any serious skater!*
- *Summer Off Ice Conditioning will be on Fridays 10:15—11:15am. This challenging workout will focus on core strength and stability, balance, explosive power, and flexibility. Off ice conditioning is vital to solid on ice performance!*
